What are we going to do?

Pfeiffer Big Sur is one of the most beautiful state parks. The park features redwoods, conifers, oaks, sycamores, cottonwoods, maples, alders and willows - plus open meadows. Wildlife includes black-tail deer, gray squirrels, raccoons, skunks, and birds, such as water ouzels and belted kingfishers. There are beautiful scenic trails. Our campsites are along the Big Sur River. We will enjoy hiking to the ocean and another trail with panoramic view of the Big Sur valley, playing volleyball and soccer, swimming in the river. There will be recitation of different supplications, prayers, and short speeches and campfire.

Food:

Halal fresh food will be prepared and served throughout the camp. Dinner will be served on Friday, breakfast, lunch & dinner will be served on Saturday, and breakfast will be served on Sunday.

What to bring:

This is a campground and you need to bring your own tent.
